BURLCO FLU SHOT CLINICS UNTIL APRIL 9

Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays at Health Department

Burlington County will offer H1N1 vaccine for county residents three days a week until April 9 at the Health Department in Westampton.

The clinics will be held Mondays from 4 to 6:30 p.m., Thursdays 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and Fridays from 1 to 4 p.m.

"We encourage residents who have not yet been vaccinated to protect themselves. Although H1N1 activity has decreased, flu virus is unpredictable and pandemic influenza typically comes in waves," said Health Officer Robert Gogats.

A limited supply of seasonal flu vaccine also is available.

Residents are asked to visit the Burlington County website at www.co.burlington.nj.us and complete the H1N1 consent form online and print a copy to bring to the clinics. If a computer is not available, consent forms can be completed at the clinics.

The Health Department is located at 15 Pioneer Boulevard in the County Complex off Woodlane Road behind the County Library.
